**COMPETITOR BULLETIN ONE issued on 29th May 2018**

1. **Reconnaissance sign on for Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> June.** All competitors must 'Sign on' for reconnaissance at **Mourne Country Hotel, Newry** between 07:30hrs and 11.00hrs and before reconnaissance commences. You will be issued with one road book and a reconnaissance card, which must be displayed on the front windscreen of the reconnaissance car. No replacement road books will be issued.
2. **Reconnaissance sign on for Friday 8<sup>th</sup> June.** All competitors must 'Sign on' for reconnaissance at **Mourne Country Hotel, Newry** between 07:30hrs and 11.00hrs and before reconnaissance commences. You will be issued with one road book and a reconnaissance card, which must be displayed on the front windscreen of the reconnaissance car. No replacement road books will be issued.
3. **Event documentation.** At reconnaissance sign on you must:
  - Collect and sign for your Road Book & Reconnaissance Card.
  - Produce your Competition licence for inspection.
  - Produce a valid Club membership card for any MSI or MSA club. (If you don't you must join NADMC)
  - Sign the declaration that you have a valid road license.
  - Sign on for REIS Insurance or sign the 'Own Insurance' declaration.
4. Competitors may make a low speed (30mph) reconnaissance of the route **between 8.00hrs and 19.00hrs on Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2018 & Friday 8<sup>th</sup> June 2018.**
5. **Stages 5/7 and 6/8.** Reconnaissance on these four stages can only be attempted between 08.00am and 11.00am on both Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> & Friday 8<sup>th</sup> June 2018. The one-way system on these stages has been reversed between 08.00 & 11.00 to allow you to complete your reconnaissance.
6. **Illegal Reconnaissance.** Web Cams have been placed on the stages. Competitors identified on the stages outside the allowed times will be refused a start on Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> June. You **will not be notified prior to this time** and your place may be allocated to a competitor on the reserve list.
7. You must provide the registration number, make and colour of the reconnaissance car to the sign on official.
8. **Penalties.** Club officials are empowered by the Clerk of the Course to stop any reconnaissance vehicle and examine their reconnaissance card. The penalty for failure to stop will be immediate exclusion from the event without refund of entry fee.
9. **Speed detection.** The special stages are used extensively by members of the public. Remember these are public roads and scenic drives. People may stop in dangerous places and children may be playing on or at the roadsides. No speeding or careless driving will be tolerated. **Speed detection devices have been acquired by the club and will be used.**
10. **Exclusion.** Any competitor found breaking the 30mph speed limit on stages or driving carelessly will have his reconnaissance card signed. **Two such signatures will result in immediate exclusion** from the event without refund of entry fee.
11. **Insurance.** All competitors can use the REIS scheme provided you can comply with their conditions. If you cannot comply and require a letter of acceptance, contact REIS for a proposal form, complete it and forward to the Insurer immediately. If you are arranging your own insurance, you must sign the 'Own Insurance' declaration.
